

Arts Everywhere: *Bringing Curriculum to Life!*



Imagination Stage's *Arts Everywhere: Bringing Curriculum to Life!* workshops use theatre arts and the curriculum in your classroom to help enhance student learning during their school day. These in-school workshops explore curriculum standards through sensory storytelling, dramatic play, and movement activities!

Arts Everywhere workshops are designed for students grades **PK3 through K** and run roughly **45-60 minutes**.

There are three **Curriculum Options** to choose from, including:

Math and Movement

Through dramatic play, music, and movement, students will explore how to use their actor's tools of body, voice, mind, and imagination to explore numbers and counting!

Science and Sensory Storytelling

Through dramatic play and multisensory storytelling, students will participate in an active retelling of Eric Carle's *The Tiny Seed*, using sensory props to help in understanding the story and the steps of how a plant grows. Student also explore what animals we might see in the garden and how an animal's growth differs from a plant!

Literacy: Bringing a Story to Life

Through dramatic play and movement, students will participate in an active storytelling of the book *Goodnight Gorilla* by Peggy Rathmann or *The Lion and the Mouse*, a retelling of Aesop's fable by Mark White, and will use their bodies to explore the main characters and events in the story.
