

Imagination Stage’s in-school residencies send professionally trained teaching artists to deliver high-quality dramatic play and performance training, designed to enhance student learning during their school day. Our programs are tailored to fit your school’s interests, scheduling needs, and budget. Residency sessions run between 45 and 90 minutes and are available to students pre-kindergarten through grade 12.

Pre-K Arts Everyday

We bring a team of teaching artists to your school to provide inner core or **specials classes for the students every day of the week**. These classes are specialized to offer drama, music, movement, and visual arts experiences that also meet the school’s early learning standards and classroom management goals. Throughout the week, teaching artists cycle through each Pre-K classroom, giving each class a different lesson each day.

Arts Learning

This program is **based on a school-chosen theme** and can be built for any age group. Some examples include creative drama classes, such as Magic Treehouse Adventures, or storytelling classes focused on student-devised scenes or stories.

Socio-Emotional Learning

In this program students are invited, through a trauma-informed teaching lens, to **devise their own work using their personal life stories**. Through creative drama and improv games, students gain confidence, discover a safe space where they can be themselves, and build emotional regulation skills.

Arts Integration

Through specifically crafted lesson plans, students **explore subjects they are learning in their classroom through performing arts**. Classroom subjects may include, but are not limited to STEM, Literacy, or Teamwork.



Every residency is customizable and the cost is relative to how frequently the class meets.
